



ROLLING SHUTTER MAINTENANCE GUIDE

Electric Operators

BY AN APPROVED CHICAGONE CERTIFIED ROLLING SHUTTER INSTALLER ONLY

1. Check to make sure rolling shutter is secured and fixed upon the previously installed application.
2. Check that the rolling shutter fully opens and closes.
3. Listen for unusual noises.
4. Thoroughly inspect rails and the box above to make sure the shutter is still intact.
5. Check alignment of slats to make sure limited drag is achieved.
6. Check the operation of all controls paying key attention to main controls.
7. Check the manual override system to make sure all safety features are still fully operational.
8. Test the battery backup on main door. (If applicable)
9. Ensure that the switch box controlling the shutter is clean, dry and that the operation functions of each button is clearly readable. Check mechanical damage to the wiring and that all connections are secure.
10. Generally clean the motor unit and make sure the motor limit adjusters are reachable.
